Three meat skewers: two by Richard Crossley (London, England, 1783 and 1801), and one by Thomas Wallis II (London, England, 1805).

Four marrow spoons. Three London examples: one by John Millington (1720), one with illegible maker's mark (1733), and one with no maker's mark (1813). Fourth spoon by George McHattie (Edinburgh, Scotland, 1817).

Three sugar nibs with monograms, London: one by Simeon Cole (c. 1763), one by Alexander Osborne (c. 1765), and one unmarked.

Two examples unmarked. All other examples marked. 20.9 ozt
